Car Parking:

We run from School shared car parking facilities, please ensure you arrive in good time.

On Arrival into the building:

No pushchairs, scooters or bikes are allowed into the premises. They must be left outside.

Only one adult is to accompany each swimmer into the building. No additional spectators are allowed inside the building.

No Food is to be brought onto the premises or consumed at any time.

No one should enter the building more than five / ten minutes before the start of their swim class.

You must head straight into the changing rooms (marked Girls and Boys).

Women (Mums) bringing boys must go into the girls changing room and Males (Dads) bringing girls must go into the boys changing room. We do not have any private separate changing cubicles at this location.

No out door shoes to be worn **poolside**. Please bring flip-flops or alternatives to change into to help keep our poolside clean for all pool users.

Please ensure swim hats and goggles (if needed) are on and properly adjusted before starting class.

Swim nappies must be worn if required and used nappies taken away with you. Full nappy details are supplied at time of booking.

When Poolside:

Please do not come through to the poolside more than a couple of minutes before your class is due to start (No earlier). Please stay seated in the changing rooms.

Please stand quietly with your swimmer to ensure you do not disturb the class swimming.

Please do not allow your children to climb on the poolside or run around, if they find waiting quietly difficult, please wait in the changing rooms until your class is starting.

At the end of class, children will be returned back to parents who will be waiting on the benches / chairs that are poolside. Please do remain seated your children will come to you.

Parents please do not come to the water area when poolside at anytime, unless you asked to do so by the class Teacher. Please remain seated at all times.

All beginner swimmers will have their own parent or carer in the water with them during Parent Support classes until you have been advised by us that this in no longer required. This will be confirmed by text message to you from feedback provided to us by their class Teacher. Unless you have received a text message confirming otherwise you will be required in the water.

No class times can be moved or adjusted without confirmation from us by text message.

Please do not try to speak to the Class Teachers whilst they are teaching, they cannot stop their class to speak to you before, during or after your class, they must focus on the safety of their swimmers at all times.

You are responsible for your children and you must stay with them at all times, before and after class to ensure their safety.

No photography or Filming at any time anywhere on the premises.

Swimming Hats: Must be worn by all swimmers with long hair. Exceptions will be made for children with Special Needs or requirements. If hats are not worn hair must be securely tied up and back.

Talcum Powder: Please do not bring talcum powder onto the premises.

Toilets: parents must accompany their children to the toilet at all times and ensure it is left flushed and clean for the next user.

These reminders are in addition to the full T&C's supplied to you at time of booking and also any verbal instructions provided by our staff that may be required at anytime to ensure safety.

We thank you all for following all of our pool rules and T&C's to help us ensure that our classes are safe for all pool users.
